HTML & CSS Developer with 6+ years of experience building responsive, cross-browser interfaces, maintaining CSS architecture, and preparing UI for integration into Angular, Vue, and React applications. Experienced in reducing technical debt in markup, standardizing reusable components, and helping teams deliver UI changes with fewer follow-up revisions. Also experienced in code reviews, documentation, onboarding, and handoff processes for frontend developers

International B2B platform built with Angular

- Initiated and created unified onboarding guidelines covering the product, team, processes, and development standards. The document was used to onboard 3 employees and became a shared team knowledge source
- Developed and introduced GitLab merge request templates for features, bugs, and updates. The templates became part of the team process, and my merge request structure was highlighted as an example during retrospectives
- Performed daily code reviews in a team of 5 HTML developers, with an overall flow of 5–7 merge requests per day
- Audited around 15 legacy CSS files in 4 working days, removed most unnecessary !important declarations, and kept only technically required cases. The changes passed QA on real devices without visual defects or rollbacks
- Worked on the UI layer of an Angular application: reused components, updated HTML structure, classes and states, and added simple conditions and UI interactivity
- Independently investigated cross-browser issues in UI components, proposed solutions, and aligned technical exceptions with frontend developers, the PM, and QA

Softcorp August 2022 – July 2025 | 3 years

International B2B platform built with Vue

- Developed responsive HTML/CSS layouts and reusable BEM blocks for integration into Vue. Prepared the structure in a way that reduced the need for follow-up clarifications and rework from frontend developers
- Adapted 10+ desktop modules for mobile devices. In one complex case, redesigned a grid of 25 cards into a usable mobile interface with horizontal scrolling
- Initiated refactoring of individual components and pages when technical debt was identified: removed unnecessary wrappers and duplication, fixed style conflicts, and agreed the scope of work with the lead and PM
- Standardized HTML/SCSS across the project: BEM naming, predictable style structure, SCSS mixins/functions for recurring solutions, and consistent implementation of UI states
- As shared components and approaches accumulated, typical refactoring of a similar page was reduced from about 1.5 weeks for the first large case to 2–3 days
- Reviewed Figma designs before development: block composition, breakpoints, states, colors, and UI kit compliance. Clarified ambiguous solutions with the PM and designer, and documented important changes in Jira

- Taught HTML, CSS, BEM, Flexbox, Grid, responsive layout, cross-browser compatibility, basic accessibility, Git, and working with Figma

- Worked with existing PHP templates and components: updated HTML structure, classes, and states without developing backend logic
- Ensured layout consistency with Figma/Photoshop designs and correct display on desktop and mobile devices
